The Yuma Community

Yuma is located in southwest Arizona approximately a three-hour drive from Arizona's capital city of Phoenix and an equal distance from San Diego and the Pacific Ocean. Travel to Yuma can also be made by flying into Yuma International Airport, served by American Airlines.

The community has a long history of settlement. Indigenous people inhabited the region well before the first Spanish explores ventured into what is now Yuma, in 1540. Situated adjacent to the Colorado River, the location was viewed as favorable for growth and travel. Spanish explorers recognized the importance of the natural river crossing, Yuma Crossing, which has played, and continues to play, a significant role in travel of people and goods across this geographic region.

Today, Yuma has grown to a population that exceeds 93,000, as of the 2010 census, and an area that is over 106 square miles. According to the United States Census Bureau population of the Metropolitan Statistical Area, which includes other incorporated and unincorporated areas of population in the region, the total MSA is over 200,000. The region is economically supported by the Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, Yuma Proving Grounds, Yuma Regional Medical Center, three separate school districts, agriculture, tourist and commerce travel, and, winter visitors. Yuma is the home of Arizona Western College, as well as branch campuses of Northern Arizona University, University of Arizona, Arizona State University, and, the University of Phoenix.

The Governing Board seeks a highly energetic education professional who has a background in teaching and educational leadership. The successful candidate will possess the skills necessary to continue the District's commitment to excellence while focused on improvement of service and outcomes.
