FCS:

Mrs. Hofenbredl gave everyone a handout out of Trust and Agency for FCS and explained the breakdown.

Question about .50 for ESL, explaining that it is for Carol Harper

Two full time custodians, the rest are 11 month.

Questions were raised about maintenance and cleaning. 1 custodian at FCS in the AM. -

- Are things are getting clean in a timely manner, are jobs getting done?
- Do we have adequate number of people to maintain and clean the building?

Building administrator is 85% to 90% satisfied with the maintenance that had occurred during the previous evenings.

- The kids need to have responsibility to help maintain the building.

Most of the increase in money has to do with the contracts

Cement slab under covered area had holes drilled into it so that it could drain so that there would be no standing water.

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Mrs Grauer gave handouts - Re: last week's questions about county work crews

Mrs O'Neil: A half-time custodian would cost \$18,923.00 - Just working during school days

\$6000.00 to just mow lawns?

Mr Vandewettering asked: What does the board think would be the best way to go about adding a maintenance person or not?

Ken White was grounds .25 FTE when he was down at SHS (was transferred to FCS).

District has been using subs to do our grounds keeping (but occasionally Bill will mow).

Motion to have District Office look into having the Sherriff's office/county crew do the mowing. Motion: Ken Piontek Second: Judy Breeden Passed: Unanimously

\$26,000 for maintenance that can be used

<u>School Dude program</u>: Looking into it - Maintenance direct, it would keep maintenance supervisor more prioritized. Efficiency.
