# A BRIEF HISTORY OF OUR ANTI-BULLYING COMMITTEE

## **Expanded Engagement & Collaboration (2021)**

- District-level monthly meetings began. Included parents, students, district administrators, and campus leaders. Strengthened transparency, student voice, and family partnership.

## **Refined Structure & Shared Leadership (2026)**

- Two district meetings per semester with rotating parent representatives and student participation each semester to ensure focused dialogue and authentic engagement.

## **Campus-Level Implementation & Ongoing Focus**

- Monthly campus ABC/PBIS meetings aligned to two campus-specific goals. Proactive, data-informed, and centered on prevention and positive culture.

- Review campus behavior data and discuss solutions


