## What is PBIS?

PBIS alters environments, teaches appropriate skills and **rewards appropriate behaviors**.<sup>vi</sup> In other words, rather than telling students **what not to do**, the school will **focus on the preferred behaviors**.<sup>vii</sup>

## PBIS HISTORY-Connecting to MTSS

#### • History of PBIS at BMS:

- Becker Middle School was given a grant (2009-2010) which provided 2 years of training in School-wide Positive Behavior Intervention & Support for the leadership team at that time.
   We have been providing a PBIS hybrid model since then.
- PBIS COMMITTEE Meets monthly to discuss MTSS TIER 1 data/curriculum
  - Fostering Resilient Learners book read by ALL staff this past summer
    - Share out at staff meetings
- MTSS: Multi-Tiered System of Support
  - Meeting the needs of students
    - TIER 1: 100% of ALL students
    - TIER 2: 15% of students needing interventions/support
    - TIER 3: 10% of students needing interventions/support

Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) is the process through which children and adults understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions.
