TITLE: Admission of Resident Students

As a general rule, a studentpupil's school residence is where studentpupil's parents/guardians live. As long as the parent who has guardianship of the child resides within the school district boundaries, the child is entitled to attend the St. Louis Park Public Schools. Also, aAny student who has reached the age of majority and resides within the school district may enroll. attend the St. Louis Park Public Schools.

At the time of registration, the enrollment center will verify and document the residency of parents or guardians for students who are not yet of age. If the parents do not live together, both parents' addresses will be recorded. principal or a designee shall determine and make suitable notation of the residence of the parents/guardians for those pupils who have not reached the age of majority. If the parents are not living together, the whereabouts of both should be ascertained.

All cases involving questions of residence shall be brought to the attention of the enrollment center school principal. All cases, which after investigation, have been determined to require the payment of tuition shall be reported to the Business Office.
