Students will encourage fellow students to reach out for help when they feel like they have reached the end of their resources. They will hold an assembly in the fall of 2021 to announce what their group is about; Zanen and Kendra Pitts have agreed to come to Browning to assist in this kickoff event, date tbd. They will hold fundraising events to help offset costs to travel to Warrior Movement events.
