The maximum allowable tuition rate is set by formula, as seen in the attachment.

The tuition rate is based on the costs incurred by the district that is funded through local property taxes. Therefore when determining the rate total cost is reduced by state aid to set this rate. For the 2023-24 school year the state contribution increased significantly so that district tax rates would be reduced. Thus, the decrease in the tuition rate is caused by increased funding from the state intended to reduce local property taxes. This is the cause of the reduction in the rate from the current \$7,000 to \$5,200.
