Dear Mr. Gonzalez,

We were recently asked by Administration if there were any improvements we should consider to enhance the Field House projects. Our response was adding brick/stone/stucco to the rear elevations of the buildings that are currently scheduled as Metal Panels. (These elevations are not visible from the typical paths of circulation on the campuses)

To acquire the cost for this revision, we issued Proposal Request 3 to replace metal panels with brick, stone, and stucco on the rear elevations of the building. The work would include a 4" wider foundation for the additional thickness of the material.

The proposed cost of the work is **\$46,657.00** for both schools.

The cost represents an increase of \$8.60 per square foot of wall area and is therefore reasonable and worthy of consideration.
