For the April 2019 School Board Meeting

The QISD Technology director responded to 48 calls for assistance since the March 2019 board meeting. Our elementary teacher seem pleased with the recent board approval of Chromebook Carts at that campus and the students have been exploring several applications. I have spent a good bit of time at the elementary answering questions the teachers have about their technology. TELPAS testing using our high school computer lab went smoothly in early March. We will have some online testing using the student chromebooks in April and also in May. In the fall of 2018, I configured our high school chromebooks so the students could take practice STAAR testing on their chromebooks, should the teacher desire to. Our combined social media usage for the past 30 days stands at 14,591 hits as our busy spring continues. Thanks for our coaches, UIL sponsors and school administrators for keeping this information updated for the parents to access. Monthly software patches for our district wireless access points, firewall, network switches and iMac computer labs have been installed. The Windows build 1809 security updates for our servers and VMWare clients have already been installed. iOS 12.2 and OS X 10.14.4 have been released for Apple devices. Google Chromebook OS version 73 has been released and pushed out to the student chromebooks.
