- All disciplines across levels (K-12) have dedicated curriculum and instructional leadership allocated through structure and staffing.
- Leadership roles, contributing expertise in the content area, entail shared responsibility for curriculum and assessment design and implementation, instructional coaching, professional learning, and data analysis to inform curricular and instructional decision-making at the district, school, and class level.
- The leadership structure is designed to be responsive to the needs of the district, allowing flexibility for curriculum design work and affording equity in terms of opportunities for staff members to move into leadership positions in the district in their content area.
