- 1) On page 6 of Board Workshop #4, you indicate that the increased revenue with a successful TRE would generate \$6.4 Million. Of that total, the graphic indicates that 12.5% (\$800,000) of that revenue would come from Homeowner's Property Taxes. In a recent Moak, Casey study conducted on behalf of the school district they estimated for 2016-17, a successful TRE with an increase of 13 cents would generate \$1,964,700 through the "local effort". The local effort they defined included both homeowner and business (commercial) taxes. Your graphic does not depict what Moak, Casey has delineated. Why? ***The people that mostly attend board meetings are local residents and not commercial business owners. The information provided targeted the audience that attends public board meetings.***
