School Choice

ALTHOUGH VOUCHERS, REPRESENTED AS EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNTS, WERE PASSED BY THE TEXAS SENATE, THE TEXAS HOUSE SUCCESSFULLY SQUASHED THE LEGISLATION BY A 2-TO-1 MARGIN. Assessment & Accountability

During the 85th Legislative Session:

- HB 22 reduced the accountability domains, lowered the weight of state exams to near 50%, and allowed for local accountability plans. However, legislation did not impact the A – F rating system.
- HB 657 provides limitations to retesting students served under special education who failed a state assessment.
- HB 2130 initiated a study on the impact of state assessments on students served under special education.

School Financing

The Legislature failed to pass meaningful school finance reform during the 85th Legislative Session. However, there was a call for the creation of a commission to study school finance reform.

Facilities Funding

HB 1081 increased the maximum New Instructional Facilities Allotment from \$250 to \$1,000 for each student in average daily attendance. Local Control/ Governance & Taxation DURING THE 85TH LEGISLATIVE SESSION, AN AMENDMENT TO SB 1566 MANDATED THE POSTING OF DISTRICT OF INNOVATION PLANS. NO OTHER LEGISLATION WAS PASSED THAT LIMITED THE FLEXIBILITY OF DISTRICTS OF INNOVATION. Initiating the Conversation
