The Seventh Grade Talent Search identifies bright students based on their standardized test scores achieved while attending elementary. Candidates are invited to take the ACT or SAT college entrance exams as seventh graders, which allows them greater insight into their academic abilities. In addition, they gain valuable benefits and have access to unique resources for gifted students. Ten of our seventh graders participated in taking the ACT college entrance exam. Two of the students scored at or above the national level of recent high school graduates on the ACT.
