Help with health insurance:

Siskiyou Community Health Center's school based health centers (at Evergreen, LBMS and IVHS) now have applications on hand to help families apply for health insurance for their children. Many children who would not qualify for Oregon Health Plan previously because their family income was a little above the threshold may now be able to qualify for free or very low cost health insurance through the state -provided "Healthy Kids" program. A family of 4 making as much as \$66,000/year may now be able to qualify for this insurance. Please call the school based health center for more information or to pick up an application packet!!



Child Find for Special Education

Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age. The Three Rivers School District requests assistance with the identification of any disabled children ages Birth through 21 who are not enrolled or currently being served in one of the District's schools.
