WHEREAS, Costa Mirada, Ltd., provided a payment in the amount of \$42,400.00 in satisfaction of its 2016 obligation under the contract, and may provide additional payments in the coming years to the District;

WHEREAS, the South San Antonio Independent School District Board of Trustees continues to seek new opportunities for its students to be successful and attend a college or university of their choice upon graduation from SSAISD;

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to devote a portion of the PILOT funds received now and in the future from Costa Mirada for a scholarship program for SSAISD students that graduate from South San High School; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to devote a portion of the PILOT funds received now and in the future from Costa Mirada to help fund mini-grants for individual classrooms which would help fund creative classroom projects district wide; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that an educational purpose is served by approving the use of PILOT funds from Costa Mirada, Ltd., for a scholarship program for its graduates and a mini-grant program, which the Board believes will directly benefit those students by helping them attend colleges and universities to pursue higher education and increase the rigor of curriculum for current students which would have a direct effect on instruction.
