- □ Currently have 300 students enrolled
- □ We have already completed one six weeks of the second semester!! Time is flying. Graduation will be here before we know it.
- □ Jostens will be coming around Spring Break to pass out cap and gown graduation material.
- □ We are enjoying a month of celebrating Black History. LaShonda Boyd has led the staff and students through fun, historical facts. We also have posters around the building showing some of the historical facts, and will culminate this month with a Black History recognition and celebration on February 26, 2025 at 2:00PM in the Old Gym.
- □ Friday school for attendance recovery and EOC Bootcamp with Dr. Asberry has been attended weekly. - □ I have begun meetings with Tour de Italia in planning the bike race for June 21. This organization pours a lot of money into our students and community. They are quite appreciative of the work our staff, students and community pour into this event.
- □ It is already almost March. We continue to press on in UIL competitions with students competing in Band, Powerlifting, Softball, Baseball, and Track. FFA continues to have success in shows around the state. Cheer advanced in the National Competition at Orlando!!!!!!

- □ IHS Band continues to prepare for UIL Solo and Ensemble competitions. Adela Garcia has already accomplished State Qualifier for the 2025 school year.
- □ We continue to provide opportunities for students to participate in ACT, TSI, and dual credit meetings with Navarro College. We are also in the process of evaluating and revising the dual credit handbook as well as the testing calendar.
- □ Mrs. Barrett is also planning trips to MCC and UNT just to give students a view of what is out there.
