New Course Name: Engineering Research and Design- Fablab II Prerequisite: Introduction to Engineering and Design (Fablab 121201-121202) Course Code: Location: Denfeld Credit: .5 per semester Grades: 9-12

This course builds off the skills learned in the Introduction courses. Students will research and apply skills in a variety of engineering and design fields such as: electrical, mechanical, civil, and machine technician. This hands-on course will allow students independently use STEM standard skills to design, prototype, and build a variety of projects using 2-D and 3-D software and fabricate almost anything using the equipment available to them in the FAB LAB. A great deal of emphasis is placed on learning at your own pace, creating things that interest you and mastery of software and equipment.
