

## How to enroll:

#### 1. Create a digital account.

A digital account is needed to participate in Fred Meyer Community Rewards. If you already have a digital account, simply link your Shopper's Card to your account so that all transactions apply toward the organization you choose.

#### 2. Link your Card to an organization.

Selecting the organization that you wish to support is as simple as updating the Fred Meyer Community Rewards selection on your digital account.

- 1. Sign in to your digital account.
- 2. Search for Neah-Kah-Nie School District #56.
- 3. Select the appropriate organization from the list and click "Save".

Your selected organization will also display in the Fred Meyer Community Rewards section of your account. If you need to review or revisit your organization, you can always do so under your Account details.

#### 3. Your organization earns.

Any transactions moving forward using the Shopper's Card number associated with your digital account will be applied to the program, at no added cost to you. Fred Meyer donates annually to participating organizations based on your percentage of spending as it relates to the total spending associated with all participating Fred Meyer Community Rewards organizations.

# **Immunizations for School**

Shots are required by law for children who attend public schools, private schools, preschools, childcare facilities, and Head Start programs in Oregon. Nearly every place that provides care for a child outside the home requires shots or an exemption to stay enrolled (<u>more info</u>).

## Why is it important to keep copies of immunization records?

Most people are busy and have trouble remembering a shot from years back. Keeping a shot record of immunizations ensures that children will not miss any immunizations. Immunization record are an important part of permanent medical records that will be needed throughout life. It's up to the guardians to make sure children are protected and up to date on immunizations.

If your student is due for an immunization, you will receive a letter in the mail stating what vaccine is due. Oregon Exclusion date for all students is **Feb 19th 2025**.

We are not always by our phone, so by emailing us it will help keep your student's attendance up to date!



We understand that students miss school due to illness, appointments or for a pre-arranged absence, but we want to partner with you to make sure your student is as successful as possible. Students with strong attendance are more likely to succeed in school and in future employment. All absences impact a student's performance and they miss out on valuable instructional time. Emailing or calling the office to let us know they won't be here is a start to keeping them on track!

## CELL PHONE POLICY AT NKN MIDDLE SCHOOL


We understand it's important that you have a way to reach your child, but just a reminder about cell phone usage at school.

- Students should not carry their phones or have them during class. They need to be turned off and kept in their locker during the school day (including breakfast and lunch).
- If a student needs to make a phone call, they are allowed to use the office phone during morning break and lunch (and of course for an emergency situation).
- Students may use their phone and/or watch on the bus (to and from school), but upon arriving to school, phones and watches must be turned off.
- Please encourage your student to leave their phones turned off during their school day.
- If you need to reach your student for an urgent matter, please call the office and we would be happy to get a message to them.
- Students who do not follow the cell phone policy will have to check their phone into the office each morning upon arriving to school.



# **Dress Code and Grooming**

The district's dress code is established to promote appropriate grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption, and avoid safety hazards. Students are expected to dress appropriately and modestly for school and all school sponsored activities and events. The daily clothing/attire should be



conducive toward an educational environment and should not be disruptive of school operations and the educational process.

- 1. Clothing or other adornments which promote weapons/violence/alcohol/tobacco/drugs, or have offensive/profane pictures or sayings are not permitted.
- 2. Clothing must cover the back and the front of the student, exposed undergarments are not acceptable.
- 3. Clothing should promote modesty and safety while students are

engaged in physical activity.

# **Upcoming...... Student Health Survey**

#### Dear Parent/Guardian:

Our school is participating in the Student Health Survey (SHS), a survey sponsored by the Oregon Health Authority Public Health Division and the Oregon Department of Education. The survey asks about health risk behaviors of students in grades 6, 8 and 11. The survey will be conducted online in the classroom and includes questions about student health and safety, mental and behavioral health, school climate and culture, and risk and protective factors.

Taking the Student Health Survey poses minimal risk to your child, who may feel embarrassed or uncomfortable answering some of the questions. Survey procedures have been designed to protect your child's privacy and allow for anonymous participation. If your child is not comfortable answering a question, he or she can leave it blank. While We encourage all students to participate, the decision to participate is voluntary. You may opt to send a refusal for your child's participation. Your child will have the chance to refuse at the time of the survey. There will be no action against you or your child if you or your child does not participate. Student Health Survey, Notification Letter and Opt out form will be sent via email next week.
