The District

The Tupelo Public School District is governed by five school board members appointed by the Mayor and City Council. One board member is appointed every year to serve a five year term.

The board is responsible for the appointment of the Superintendent, who is the chief administrator of the district.

The Tupelo Public School District is one of 152 school districts and one of 81 separate districts in Mississippi.

The district is one of two districts in the state with 7,000 to 8,000 students.

General Statement School Year 2010-2011

The Budget

The Tupelo Public School District budget is a plan of financial operations which provides a basis for the planning, controlling, and evaluating of school district activities.

Section 37-61-9, Miss. Code of 1972, as amended, requires all public school districts in Mississippi to prepare an annual operating budget. The Tupelo Public School District's annual operating budget is adopted by the Board of Trustees and is filed with the local taxing authority (the City of Tupelo) on or before August 15th of each year. Section 37-61-21, Miss Code 1972, as amended, authorizes the school district to amend the budget at any time during the fiscal year.

The basis of accounting used in the budget preparation is modified accrual.

A district's basis of accounting determines when transactions are reflected in the financial records. Utilizing the modified accrual basis of accounting, revenues are recognized in the accounting period in which they become available and measurable, and expenditures are recognized in the accounting period in which the fund liability is incurred, if measurable, except for interest on general long-term debt, which is recognized when due.

Personnel

The district currently has 1,316 full & part-time positions with a monthly payroll cost of approximately \$4,452,000, including fringe benefits. The district has 646.85 licensed personnel positions, including teachers, principals and administrative staff. Teacher salaries range from \$34,228 to \$71,756, not inclusive of a \$6,000 National Board Certification program funded by the state.

The projected average teacher salary for 2010-2011 is \$45,012.

The average teacher salary guide supplement is projected to be \$4,132 this school year.

The district employs 106 National Board Certified Educators.

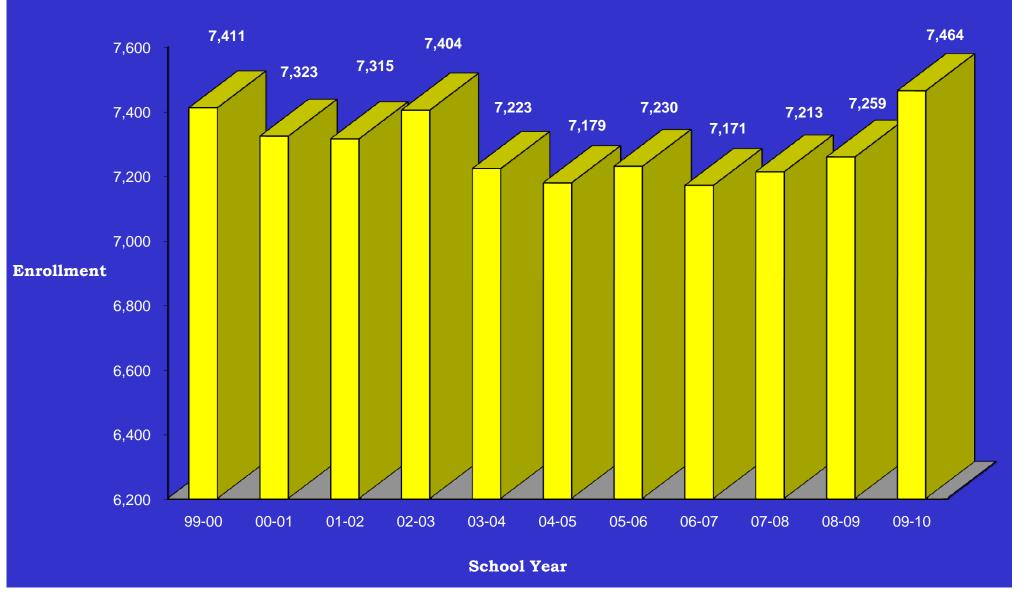
The district also employs approximately 126 non-certified instructional personnel positions (assistant teachers/teacher aides, etc.)

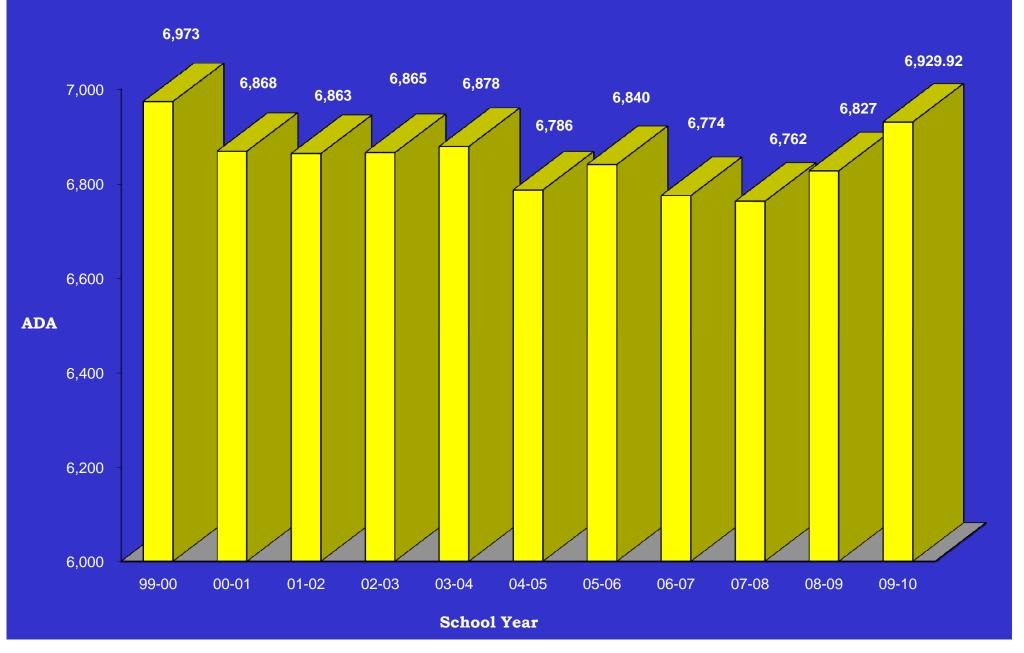

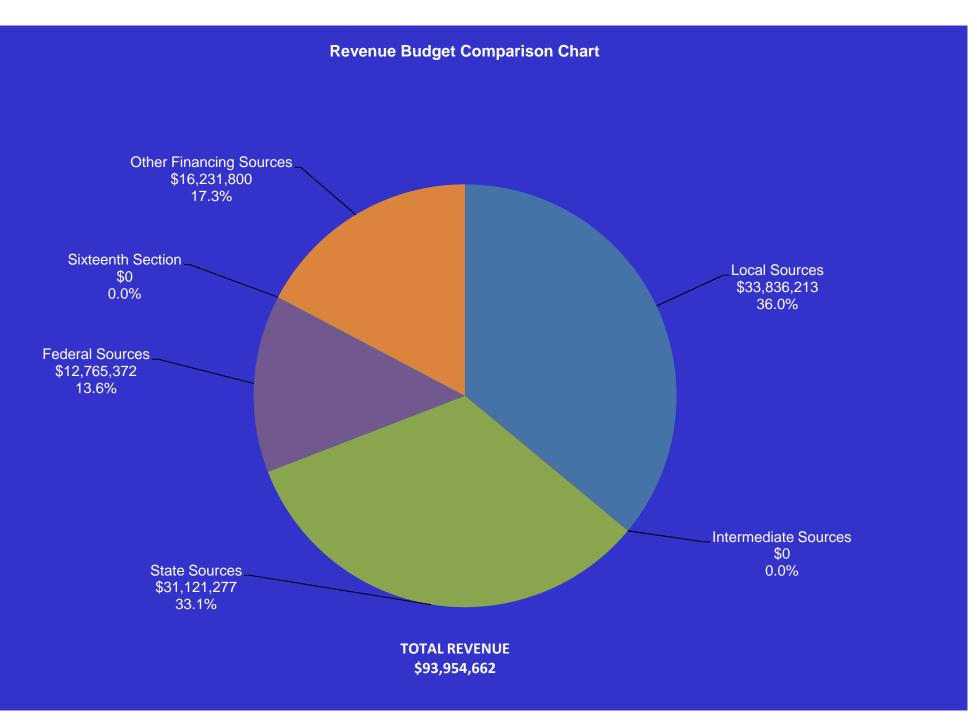

RESOLUTION REQUESTING A TAX LEVY FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE TUPELO PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

WHEREAS, Mississippi Code 1972 21-23-45, as amended, provides for the annual levy of municipal ad valorem taxes for the fiscal year next succeeding the regular meeting of the City Council in September of each year and specifies that those taxes shall include taxes for school purposes; and

WHEREAS, Mississippi Code 1972 27-39-307 provides that municipalities may make levies for special purposes as authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, Mississippi Code 1972 37-57-1, et seq., provides a mandatory tax levy shall be fixed by an order adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Tupelo Public School District for the support of the school district in the amount fixed in this order, subject to the maximum limitation provided by law; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustees now finds and determines that the amount of tax dollars required for the purpose of supplementing teachers' salaries, purchasing furniture, supplies and materials, and for all other lawful operating and incidental expenses of the school district, funds for which are not provided by the Mississippi Adequate Education Program fund allotments, is \$28,405,545 which includes the estimated value of Homestead Exemption reimbursement.

WHEREAS, Mississippi Code 1972 37-57-23 provides that the governing authorities of a municipality constituting a public school district shall annually levy such taxes upon all of the taxable property of the school district in such amount as may be necessary to pay the interest of and principal upon all bonds and other indebtedness of the public school district; and

WHEREAS, an additional tax levy is required in such amount as may be calculated to be necessary to pay the interest of and principal upon all previous bonds and other indebtedness of the Tupelo Public School District; and

WHEREAS, an additional tax levy is further required in the amount of \$1,458,327 which is necessary to pay the interest and principal upon the short-term indebtedness of the Tupelo Public School District.

WHEREAS, an additional tax levy is further required in the amount of \$3,172,845, which is necessary to pay the interest and principal of the bonded indebtedness of the Tupelo Public School District;

WHEREAS, Mississippi Code 1972 37-7-409 Annotated, provides that the governing authorities of a municipality constituting a public school district shall annually levy such taxes upon all of the taxable property of the school district in such amount as may be necessary to pay any monetary obligation of the school district for the operation of a regional vocational education center; and

WHEREAS, the Tupelo Public School District and the Lee County School District have entered into an agreement for the operation of the Tupelo/Lee County Vocational Technical Center and an additional tax levy is required in such amount as may be calculated to be necessary to pay the Tupelo Public School District's share for the operation of such regional vocational technical center; and

WHEREAS, an additional tax levy is further required in the amount of \$210,000 which is necessary to pay Tupelo Public School District's share of the operational expenses of said vocational technical center; and

WHEREAS, , Mississippi Code 1972 37-57-108 & 27-39-333 Annotated allow the Tupelo Public School District to issue a shortfall note to be repaid from a special tax levied by the City Council of the City of Tupelo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Tupelo Public School District, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the findings contained herein above are determined to be true and correct.

SECTION TWO: That the City Council of the City of Tupelo, Mississippi, shall be, and they hereby are, requested to levy a tax for the support of the Tupelo Public School District pursuant to Mississippi Code of 1972 37-57-1 upon all of the taxable property of such school district in the amount of \$28,405,545, which includes the estimated value of Homestead Exemption reimbursement, subject to the maximum limitation set by Mississippi Code 1972 37-57-107, for the purpose of supplementing teachers' salaries, purchasing furniture, supplies and materials, and for all other lawful operating and incidental expense of the Tupelo Public School District, funds for which are not provided by the Mississippi Adequate Education Program funds allotments.

SECTION THREE: That the City Council of the City of Tupelo, Mississippi, shall be, and they hereby are, requested to levy such additional ad valorem taxes upon all of the taxable property of the Tupelo Public School District pursuant to Mississippi Code of 1972 37-59-23, in the amount of \$1,458,327 which is necessary to pay the interest of and principal on the short term indebtedness of Tupelo Public School District.

SECTION FOUR: That the City Council of the City of Tupelo, Mississippi, shall be, and they hereby are, requested to levy such additional ad valorem taxes upon all of the taxable property of the Tupelo Public School District pursuant to Mississippi Code of 1972 37-59-107, in the amount of \$3,172,845 which is necessary to pay the interest of and principal on the bonded indebtedness of Tupelo Public School District.
