IN RE:	Closing school construction projects 0031 and 0041

<u>Project 0031</u> dating to June, 1997 involved expansion, additions and roof replacement at Consolidated School. The project amount as authorized by School Construction Grants Management was \$9,690,000. Ineligible costs reduced this amount \$1,521,614.

Due to a change in scope the actual expenditure is \$9,928,584. This figure was provided to the state in FY 2016-2017. Under the assumption that it will be certified, the eligible cost of 0031 will be \$8,406,970 after deducting the ineligible cost above.

The state's cost-sharing or reimbursement rate is 37.14%. Therefore, grant payments totaling \$3,122,349 are anticipated. Four payments have been received to-date. Presuming state acceptance of the cost revision figure, the balance to collect is \$298,125; otherwise it will be \$206,915 as approved originally.

<u>Project 0041</u> was submitted and approved in June, 1999 in the amount of \$378,000. The construction involved expansion of the lower level of the middle school. Allied ineligible costs were pegged at \$83,234. Examination of invoices has identified a total cost of \$443,462. This amount has been forwarded to Grants Management. Presuming acceptance, the net cost of the project will be \$360,228.

The reimbursement rate for 0041 is 35%. Payments totaling \$126,080 are anticipated. One payment has been received to-date, and the expected payments remaining will total \$29,048 should the revised cost figure be accepted. If disallowed, the balance collectable is \$6,136.

Action by the Board is required to advance these projects to their respective next payment levels. The Board needs only make and accept a motion to declare the projects closed.
