TOPIC: Recognition of State Champions

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District adopt the attached resolutions recognizing Stevenson High School swimmer Nick Arakelian, for achieving the 2014 Michigan High School Athletic Association Division 1 state record in the 500-yard freestyle and overall state record in the 200-yard Individual Medley and for being named the State of Michigan Swimmer of the Year; and Franklin High School wrestler Jordan Atienza, for capturing the MHSAA Division 1 state championship in the 160-pound class.

RATIONALE:

Nick Arakelian, a senior, has had an accomplished career as a swimmer in our School District, culminating this season by breaking his own Division 1 record in the 500-yard freestyle; breaking an all-class school record and setting the overall state record in the 200 IM.

Jordan Atienza, a senior, has had an outstanding career as a wrestler in our School District, culminating with a 64-1 overall record the state championship title, which is a first for Franklin High School.
