<b>JAA – NEW Sept 2009</b>	Student Policy Objectives	OPTIONAL. Defines the objectives in HB2362 and HB 2693 for creating string schools. Committee decision: Adopt as per OSBA
<b>JE – NEW Sept 2011</b>	Attendance	OPTIONAL. Defines expectations for attendance and adds in the requirement that schools notify parents if a student has an unplanned absence (HB 3197). Committee decision: Adopt as per OSBA
<b>JEA- REVISED May 2012 and Feb 2013</b>	Compulsory Attendance	RECOMMENDED. Clarifies that 5 and 6 year olds enrolled in public school are expected to maintain regular attendance. Details requirements for notification to the ESD of home schooling. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JEC- REVISED Feb 2012</b>	Admissions	OPTIONAL. Clarifies admission options for students who are not yet 21 at the beginning of the current school year and have not yet earned a diploma. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JECB – REVISED Sept 2011 and Jan 2014</b>	Admission on Non-resident Students	REQUIRED and RECOMMENDED. HB 3681 removes the requirement of resident district consent for an interdistrict transfer. Establishes procedures for advising nonresident students of options to transfer into the district. Eliminates reciprocity agreements between districts. House Bill 2747 creates new provisions and amends Section 20, Chapter 718 Oregon Laws 2011 which make changes to the interdistrict, tuition and open enrollment transfer process beginning with students who seek admission in the 2014-2015 school year Committee decision: Revise as per Stephanie Allen-Hart and OSBA
<b>JECB – AR1- NEW Sept 2011 and Jan 2014</b>	Admission of Non-resident Students	OPTIONAL. See above Committee decision: Revise as per Stephanie Allen-Hart and OSBA
<b>JEC – REVISED Sept 2012</b>	Assignment of Students	OPTIONAL. Removes the NCLBA school improvement/school choice provision. Clarifies that a student who is the victim of a

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		<p>violent crime while in or on school grounds or attending a school defined as persistently dangerous may transfer schools and be provided transportation. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA</p>
<b>JECDA – REVISED Dec 2010</b>	Transcript Evaluation	<p>OPTIONAL. Adds in language relating to transcripts from military-based schools, home school, on line and other distant learning methods. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA</p>
<b>JDECDA –AR – REVISED Dec 2010</b>	Transcript Evaluation Procedures	<p>OPTIONAL. See above. Eliminates CIM/CAM language. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA</p>
<b>JED - REVISED Sept 2011</b>	Student Absences and Excuses	<p>REQUIRED. Wording change. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA</p>
<b>JF/JFA – NEW Jan 2014</b>	Student Rights and Responsibilities	<p>REQUIRED. HB 2192 defines core rights and responsibilities for students. Committee decision: Adopt as per OSBA</p>
<b>JFC – REVISED Jan 2014</b>	Student Conduct	<p>REQUIRED. HB 2192 adds in language that discipline be administered “without bias”, requires a code of conduct be distributed to students, parents and employees, and requires that a school provide a handbook with rules specific to the school. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA</p>
<b>JFCEB – NEW Sept 2009</b>	Personal Communication Devices and Social Media	<p>OPTIONAL. Guidance on use of personal communication devices and social media. Committee decision: Do not adopt at this time – HB 2426 has new language pending. There is a need for the policy but this language is not current.</p>
<b>JFCEB – AR – NEW Sept 2009</b>	Personal Communication Devices and Social Media	<p>OPTIONAL. See above. Committee decision: Do not adopt at this time – HB 2426 has new language pending. There is a need for the policy but this language is not current.</p>
<b>JFCHA – NEW Sept 2011</b>	Use of Alcohol for Cooking	<p>CONDITIONALLY REQUIRED. If alcohol is to be allowed in cooking classes, competitions or demonstrations, this policy must be adopted. Committee decision: Do not adopt. No plans to allow alcohol to be used in culinary classes.</p>
<b>JFCJ – REVISED Feb 2012 and Jan 2014</b>	Weapons in School	<p>REQUIRED. HB 2192 removed the requirement of expulsion for lesser weapons offenses but keeps it in place for firearms. Districts need to consult with their insurance carrier regarding the issue of allowing persons with concealed weapons permits to have firearms on campus. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA</p>

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<b>JG – REVISED Jan 2014</b>	Student Discipline	REQUIRED. Clarifies discipline should be targeted to encouraging changes in behavior that allow a student to remain in school, adds in “without bias”, details core reasons for expulsions, and requires parents, students and employees all receive a code of conduct handbook. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHC – REVISED Sept 2009</b>	Student Health Services and Requirements	RECOMMENDED. HB 2693 requires a nursing service ration for medically fragile and medically complex students. The bill encourages but does not require a school nurse for every 750 students by the year 2020. Details screening requirements and handling of sick or injured students. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHCA – NEW Dec 2010</b>	Physical Examination of Students (form)	REQUIRED. This form is required to be used for all sports physicals after April 30, 2011. Committee decision: Adopt as per OSBA
<b>JHCA/JHCB – REVISED Oct 2013 and Jan 2014</b>	Immunizations and Health Examinations	OPTIONAL. Changes immunization documentation needed. . SB132 added “philosophical belief”. Requires use of approved pre-physical examination form. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHCB – NEW Oct 2013 and Jan 2014</b>	Immunization of Students	Merged with policy above.
<b>JHCCA – REVISED June 2013</b>	Students – HIV, HBV, and AIDS	REQUIRED. OAR 333-018-0030 has been repealed and use of a different manual to guide district actions is needed. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHCCB – DELETE June 2013</b>	Students – HIV, AIDS	RECOMMENDED DELETION. With OAR 333-018-0030 repealed, this policy is no longer accurate and language is covered in above policy. <b>Committee decision: Delete as per OSBA</b>
<b>JHCCF – NEW June 2013</b>	Pediculosis (Head Lice)	OPTIONAL. Clarifies district policy on live lice and nits. Committee decision: Adopt as per OSBA
<b>JHCCF-AR – REVISED June 2013</b>	Pediculosis (Head Lice)	OPTIONAL. Provides procedures for dealing with live lice and nits. Removes the requirement that students are immediately removed from school. Districts are encouraged to consult with local health officials regarding the “no nits” policy. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHCD – REVISED May 2010</b>	Administering Non-injectable Meds to Students	REQUIRED. Allows districts to revoke permission for self-medication if the student violates policy or medical protocol.

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<b>JHCD-AR – REVISED May 2010</b>	Administering Non-injectable Meds to Students	REQUIRED. Combines non-injectable and injectable medications into one AR. Adds in guidance on handling student need for immediate bronchodilators or epinephrine. Updates protocol for disposal of medications. Adds in language absolving school staff from liability resulting from a student’s use of medications. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHCD/JHCDA –AR – NEW Oct 2013</b>	Administering Non-injectable/Injectable Meds to Students	REQUIRED. Combines the policies.
<b>JHCDA – REVISED Oct 2013</b>	Administering Injectable Meds to Students	REQUIRED. Provides guidance on staff administering injectable medications. HB 2749 requires districts to establish procedures for certain medications to be kept in the classroom if requested by the parent. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHDB – NEW May 2013</b>	Mental Health Screening Exemptions	OPTIONAL. HB 3474 allows for the parent, guardian or student to request the student not participate in the screening. Provides guidance on notification of screening and right to opt out. <b>Committee decision: Do not adopt. The district does not administer mental health screening to whole groups.</b>
<b>JHFE- REVISED Sept 2011 and May 2012</b>	Reporting of Suspected Child Abuse	REQUIRED. Child abuse has been modified to read “abuse of a child”. Details how and to who abuse is to be reported, provides immunity in a report of abuse made in good faith and expands annual training requirements for staff, students and parents. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHFE-AR – REVISED Feb 2010 and May 2012</b>	Child Abuse Reporting	REQUIRED. Details the requirements of a written report. Addresses issues of confidentiality given to the reporter but not to employees convicted of a crime under ORS 342.143. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JHFE/KN – AR – NEW Feb 2010 and May 2012</b>	Child Abuse Investigations Conducted on School Premises	RECOMMENDED. Form to be used when an abuse investigation is being conducted on district grounds. Committee decision: Adopt as per OSBA
<b>JHFF – REVISED Dec 2010 and May 2012</b>	Reporting Requirements Regarding Sexual Contact with Students	REQUIRED. Adds in student as part of the investigation. Clarifies employee contract requirements if the subject of a report is an school employee. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA

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<b>JHFF –AR – REVISED Sept 2010</b>	Sexual Complaint Form	REQUIRED. Form to be used to investigate sexual complaints, adds in witness disclosure form. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JN – REVISED Sept 2011</b>	Student Fees, Fines and Charges	OPTIONAL. SB 800 Section 15 revoked the right of a district to withhold grade reports, records and diplomas due to fees/fines owed. Allows waiver of fees/fines owed in certain circumstances. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JOA- REVISED May 2012</b>	Directory Information	REQUIRED. Clarifies directory information categories and limits the right of students/parents to refuse to release directory information in certain cases. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
<b>JOB – REVISED May 2012 and June 2013</b>	Personally Identifiable Information	REQUIRED. Expands the definition of personally identifiable information and clarifies exceptions to prior consent. Committee decision: Revise as per OSBA
