Propose to apply for Blue Sky Community Project Funds from Pacific Power for a solar system at Applegate School. Blue Sky funding awards cover up to 100 percent of the capital costs to install qualifying, new renewable energy systems for non-residential sites in Pacific Power's service area.			
The projects selected provide strong environmental, economic and educational benefits to the communities we serve. The grant submission would be in the summer of 2019. Grant recipients will be notified early 2020.			
Provide history/background information on your proposal: Given the rising costs of energy and our desire to make a difference by supporting renewable energy generation, Applegate School would like to prepare and submit an application to Pacific Power for the installation of solar project.
