INFORMATIONAL REPORT:
It is recommended that the United ISD Board of Trustees be informed about Adult Breakfast and Lunch Price Increase.
RATIONALE: The United States Department of Agriculture requires all school districts that operate a Non Pricing Program under the Community Eligibility Provision that all agencies charge for breakfast at least \$2.52 and for lunch at least \$4.54 based on Method 2 for Adult Meal Pricing. Therefore, based on the requirements imposed to school districts it is recommended that the price for only United IS staff for breakfast be increased from \$2.50 to \$2.75 and for lunch, from \$4.25 to \$4.75. The previous price increase was on October 01, 2020.
