## DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER RAIN AND FLOODING

WHEREAS, on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 2021 (as of 10:00 a.m.), the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's ("NOAA") National Weather Service continued the Flood Warning for the Oso Creek affecting Nueces County, and forecast that "moderate flooding is occurring and moderate flooding is forecast" and that Oso Creek "is expected to continue a slow fall to below flood stage this evening" and the warning remains in effect until further notice;" and

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of May 2021 (as of 10:00 a.m.), the NOAA's National Weather Service issued a Costal Flood Advisory from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and a Rip Current Statement regarding a high rip current risk through Saturday evening, and issued a Hazardous Weather Outlook forecasting "minor coastal flooding" through the weekend and early next week; and

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of May 2021 (as of 10:00 a.m.), the NOAA's National Weather Service and the National Hurricane center are monitoring an area of disturbance in the northwestern Gulf of Mexico with a "MEDIUM 40% chance of tropical development" and forecasting that "regardless of development," impacts to South Texas may include locally heavy rainfall, minor coastal flooding, increased risk of rip currents, and increased swells from tonight into Saturday and Sunday; and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of May 2021, Nueces County already suffered widespread and severe property damage, injury, and loss of life due to torrential rain and flooding; and

WHEREAS, the current flood conditions and risk of severe inclement weather with continued forecast for heavy rain and flooding in Nueces County over the next several days; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Nueces County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property in Nueces County.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF NUECES COUNTY:

- 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Nueces County pursuant to § 418.108 (a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to § 418.108 (b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued, or renewed, by the Commissioners Court of Nueces County.
- 3. Pursuant to § 418.108 (c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
- 4. Pursuant to § 418.108 (d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the County Emergency Management Plan.
  - 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
