**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the Administration's proposal on campus retirements and corresponding boundary adjustments effective for the 2026-2027 school year as presented.

**RATIONALE:**

The goal of this proposal is to ensure the District is able to continue to focus its finite resources on student programs, activities, and academic growth. This proposal represents a major element of the District's plan to reduce the 2026-2027 projected operating deficit and simultaneously address excess classroom capacity, projected enrollment decline, building ages and conditions, and natural combinations of attendance zones.

The District is committed to a thoughtful and people-centered implementation of this proposal to ensure our students continue to receive the high quality of education they deserve, that our parents are informed of the various boundary impacts and continuation of educational services, and that all impacted staff members will have positions within the District aligned with their certification and expertise.
