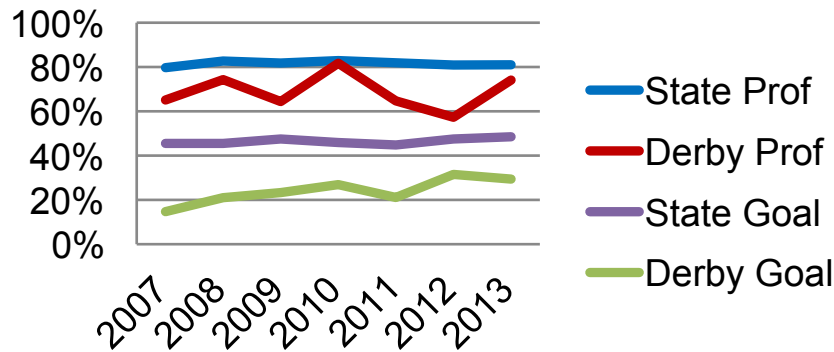

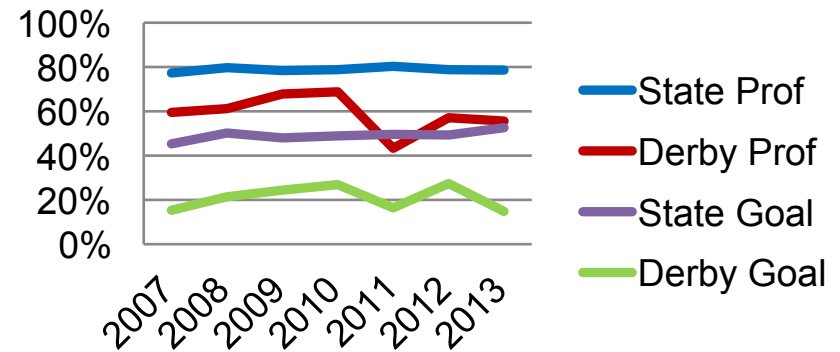
## Connecticut Academic Performance Test (CAPT) Performance

Percent of 10<sup>th</sup> Graders Scoring Proficient/Goal (successive cohort compared to Connecticut average):

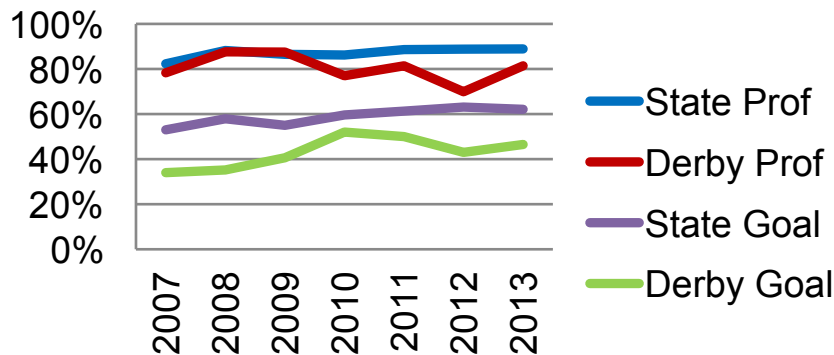

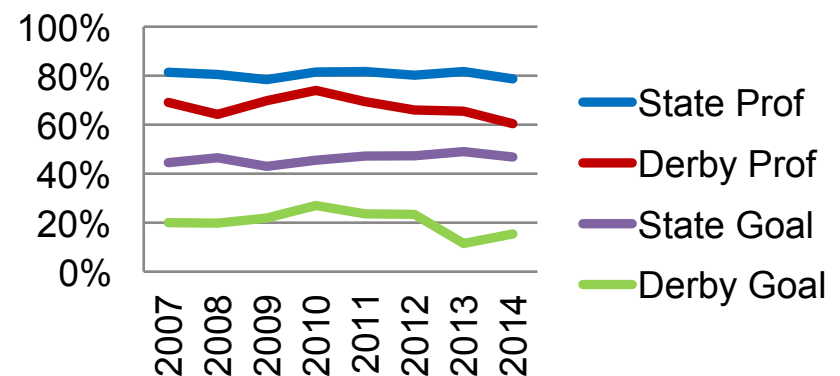

## State Four-Year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rates:

Adjusted Cohort are those students who started high school in the ninth grade for the first time and graduate in four years along with any students who enter on grade level at any point during the four year period. Student who transfer out are not included. Any student who discontinues schooling, leaves for a GED or ACD program, or tells the school they are transferring to another school, but never registers with that school are considered a Cohort Dropout, and would be included in the Non-Graduates Other column.

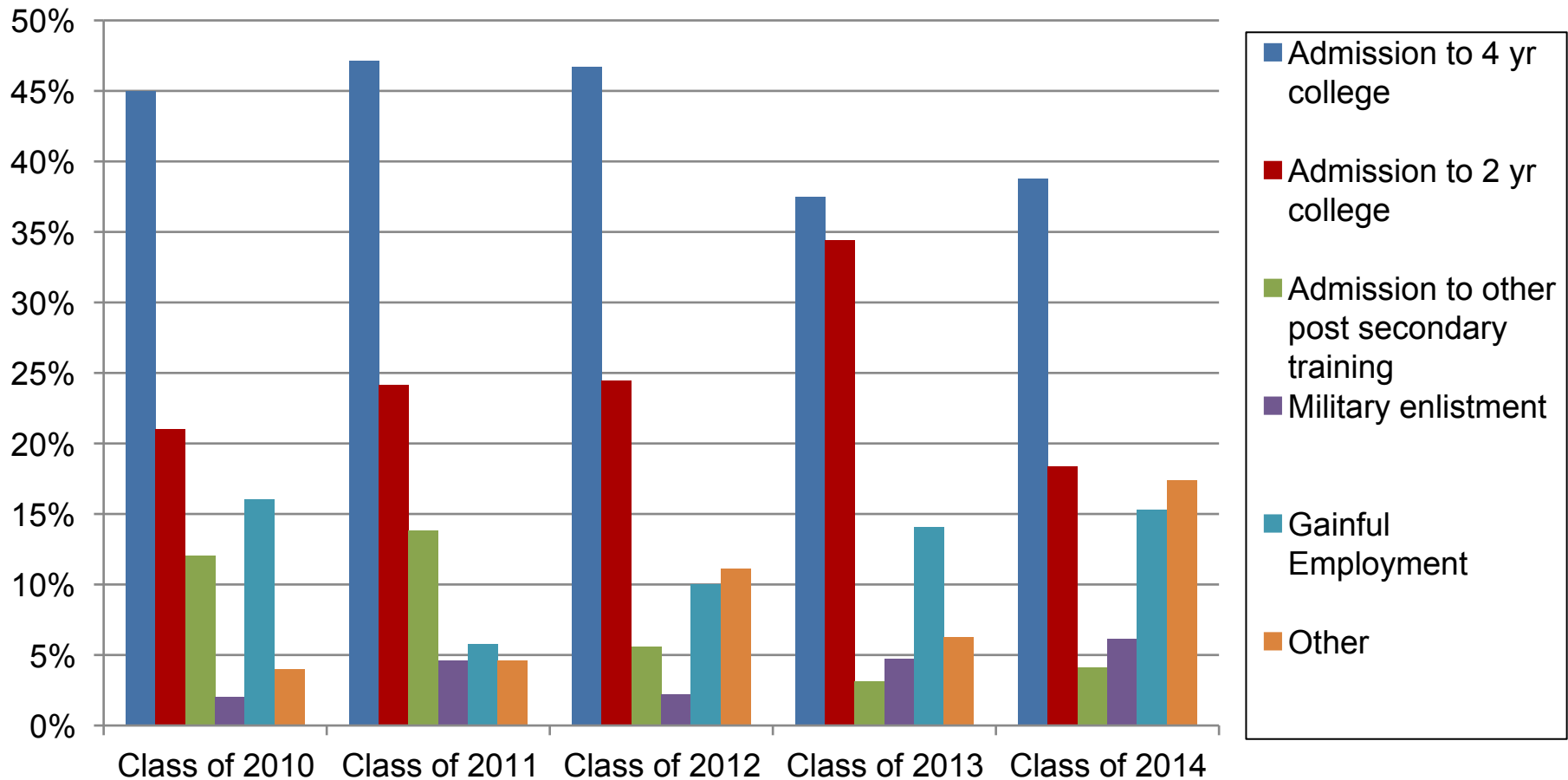
## State Five-Year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rates:

Percent of graduates

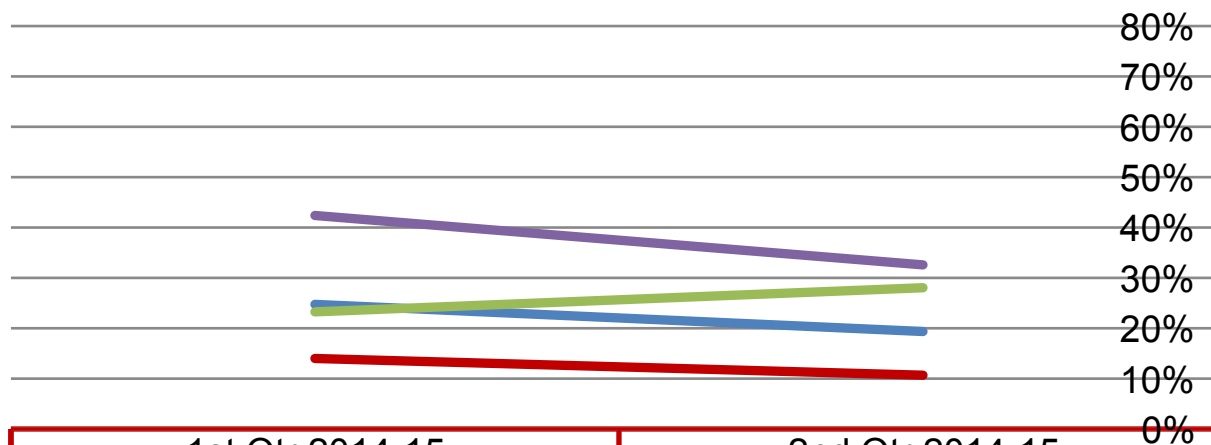

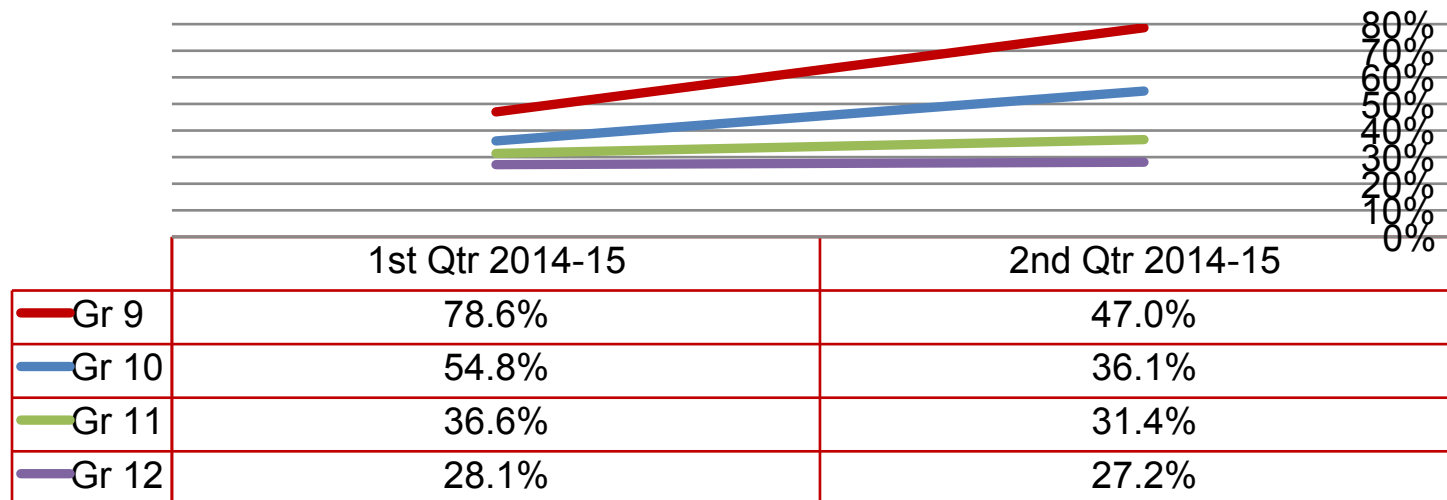
Percent of students earning 80% or above in all courses regardless of academic level:

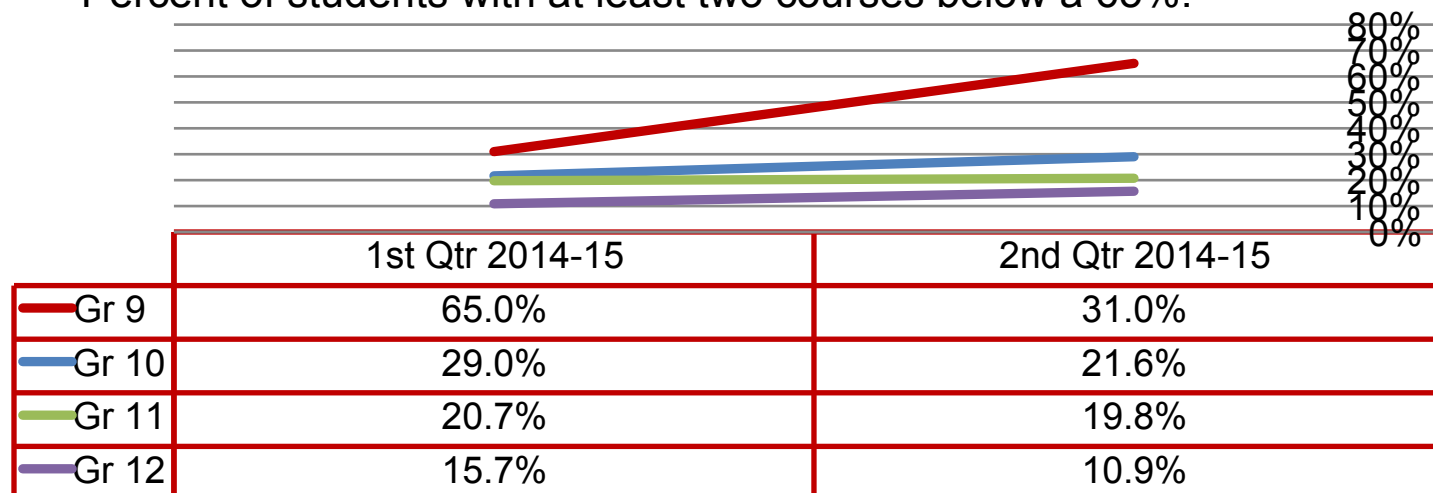
## Failing Grades

Percent of students with at least two courses below a 65%:



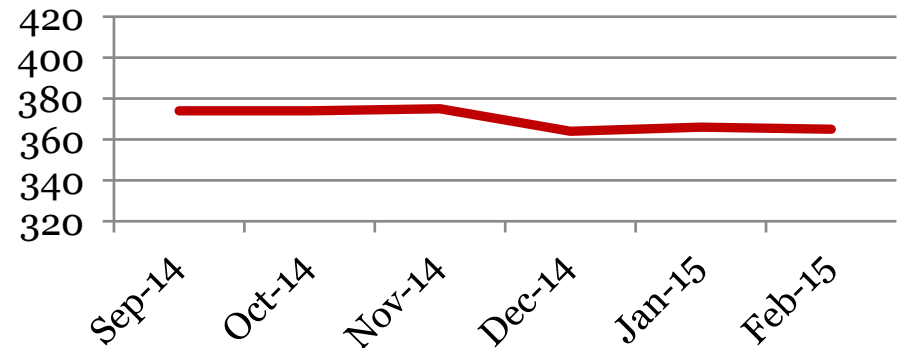

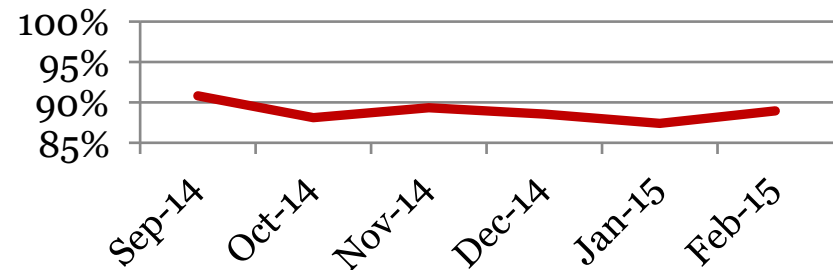

## Total Student Attendance



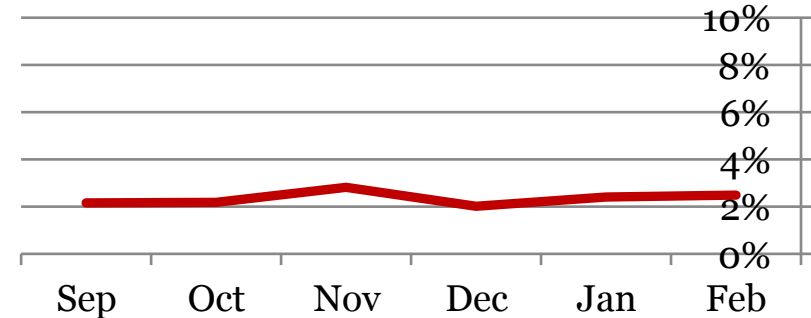

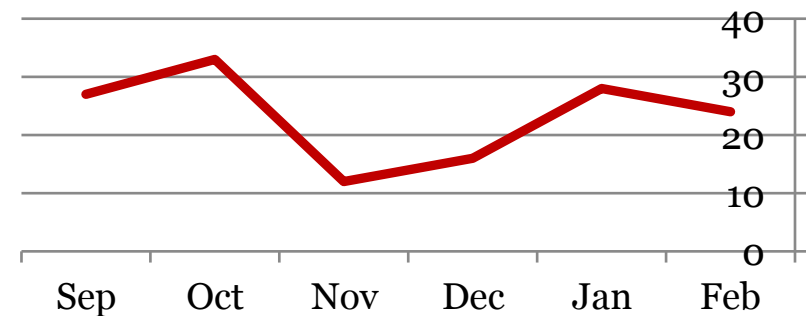

### # Students over Threshold

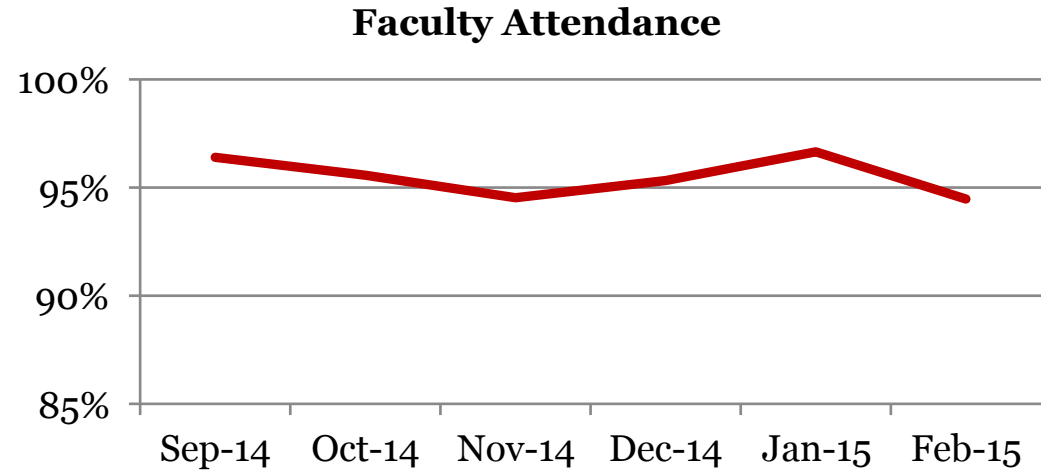

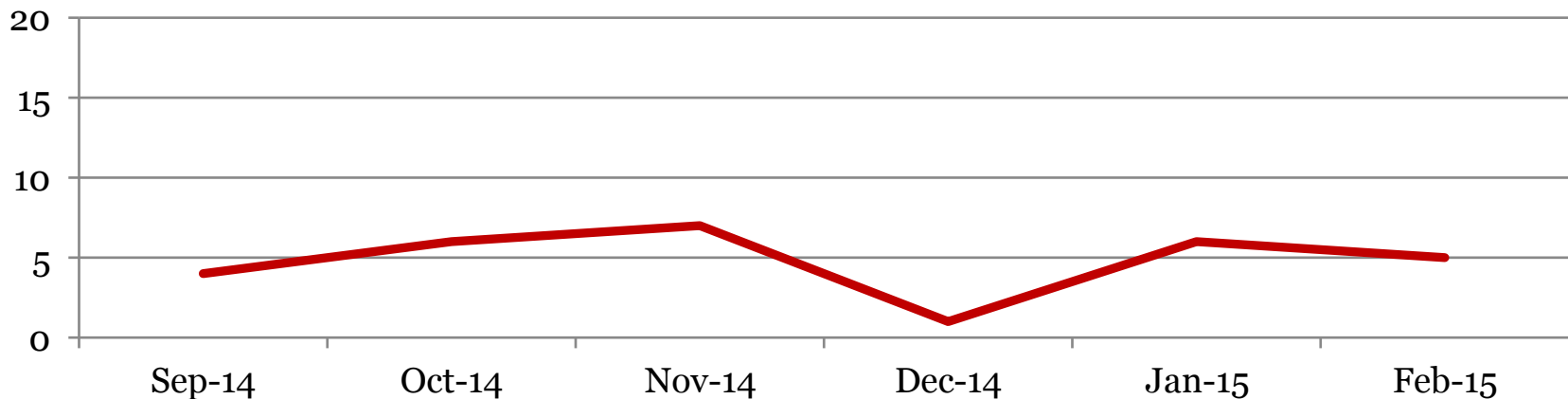

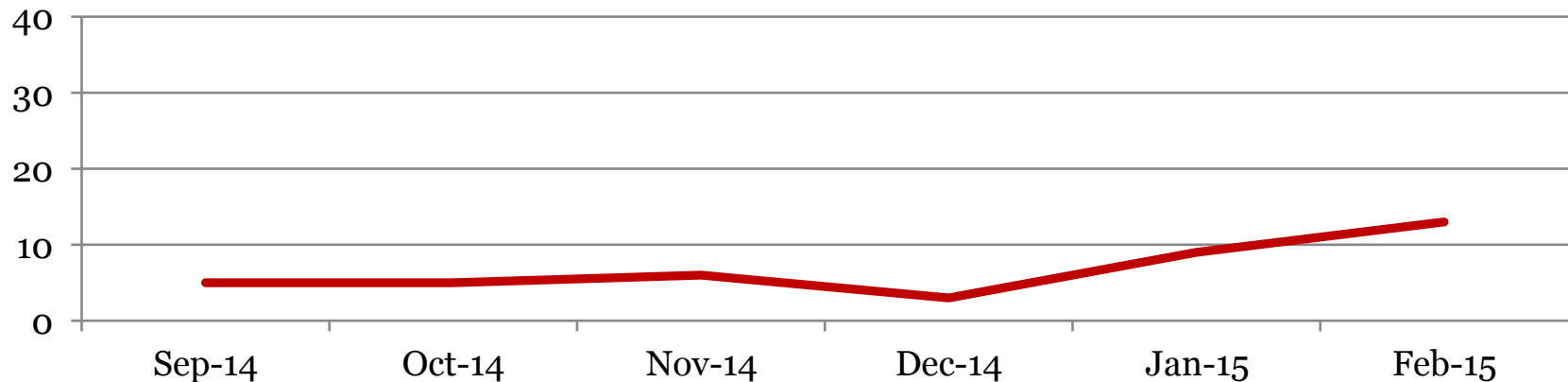
