Re: Athletic Field Proposals

I would like an opportunity to share the summer 2019 high school athletic fields bid results with the Board of Education. As mentioned to the Board at the Study Session of January 14, 2019, the bid opening for this Sinking Fund project occurred on December 6, 2018. I would like to remind you that the field turf bid accepted last year from Astrotuf was for all three high school athletic fields. This was done so that the turf field manufacturer would be consistent for all three schools' projects. During the proposed projects, the bulk of the work will be conducted at Stevenson and Franklin High Schools, but some items will also include finishing items at Churchill High School.

We are currently recommending five of the six bid categories. The scoreboard category is not being recommended now due to bid costs and low bidder participation. We will rebid this work in the near future. The recommended vendors can be found in the attached letters from Plante Moran CRESA and Foresite Design, along with the bid tabs for details. This Sinking Fund project recommendation has a bid amount of \$2,157,800.00, plus 8% contingency in the amount of \$276,653.00 for a total project sum of \$2,434,453.00, which includes two accepted bid alternates.
