To support your work around the approval of the supplemental program, please read Minn Stat § 125D.095 Subd 2. (h) and Subd 3 (b).

Since Duluth's Academic Excellence Online applied for and has been approved for comprehensive and supplemental programming in the 2014-2015 academic year, its 3-Year Review, in which the commissioner, using research based stand of quality for online learning programs, reviews all providers *will occur on August 1, 2018.* 

In this new process each online provider receives an electronic portfolio site to support its Self-Study Process. To support your understanding of new stature requirements please read the language in Minn Stat § 125D.095 Subd 7.

The department will provide Academic Excellence Online with information about the digital portfolio and an orientation to the annual review process and the three-year review a full year prior to August 1, 2018.

Lastly, the Academic Excellence Online and Duluth Public Schools is reminded of the provider obligation in Subd. 4. "(c) An online learning student has the same access to the computer hardware and education software available in a school as all other students in the enrolling district. An online learning provider must assist an online learning student whose family qualifies for the education tax credit under section 290.0674 to acquire computer hardware and educational software for online learning purposes." It is important that online students understand what it is need to participate in the online environment and get the information needed to qualify for tax credits.
