May 15, 2024

**Welcome:** Lori Barnhurst, PC Chair, welcomed everyone and established a quorum. We went over April PC minutes. Motion to approve made by Aleesa Bell, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Heather Cartwright, passed unanimously.

• Julie Reed went over the Policy Council Budget. Motion to approve made by Heather Cartwright, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Raychel Mantz, passed unanimously.

Paola Reyes was excused, Heather Linehan went over the April Budgets. We are currently 83.33% through our Continuous Grant year. Head Start (7320) has spent 73.56% of the total budget, and Head Start Training (7318) is 91.2% spent. EHS (7314) is 73% spent, and EHS Training (7315) is 74% spent. In-Kind for Head Start is at 86.75% and EHS is 87.19% received. Since the reports were run the end of April, EHS has reached 100% of In Kind, and HS is very close – give yourselves a big pat on the back! Went over the Credit Card report. Motion to approve budgets made by Josselyn McClure, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Julie Reed, passed unanimously. Making gains on In-Kind, don't stop, you're doing great!

## **Director's report** – Marianne Henderson

- New Hires: Janay Hansen TA @ FEC HS; Mercedes Bradshaw TA @ Canyon Heights. Motion to approve by Aleesa Bell, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Camille Huntsman, passed unanimously.
  - ➤ Marianne went over the enrollment report. HS Enrollment is currently at 97%. The program is currently serving 392/401 Head Start children and families, with 61 on IEP's and 170 on waitlist. EHS Enrollment is at 100%. We are serving 101/101 Early Head Start children and families, 7 are on an IFSP, and 159 on waitlist. Attendance for EHS Center Based was 82%, Head Start was 85%, EHS Home Visits was 85% and EHS Socializations was 38%.
  - ➤ USDA Reimbursement for April is Head Start \$505.44 YTD is \$3857.50, Early Head Start \$720.26 YTD is \$8298.57.
- Marianne discussed the Community Partnership Plan grant; demolition of the South Center; purchasing a car; and changing Policies and Procedures to align better with allocation funding, which were all approved May 7.
- Marianne Henderson and Shanda Parkinson discussed the Active Supervision correction plan, and everything we have implemented to keep kids safe. Motion to approve made by Jaycie Maycock, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Raychel Mantz, passed unanimously.
