





#### Percentage of STAAR Performance Across All Subjects and All Grade-Levels 2021 versus 2022











#### Percentage of Academic Growth Across All Subjects and All Grade-Levels by Student Group






Percentage of Academic Growth Across ELA/Reading and All Grade-Levels by Student Group










#### Attendance Rate Percentage (All Students) 2019, 2020, and 2021





#### Percentage of 4-Year Longitudinal Graduation Rate by Student Groups 2019-2020 and 2020-2021







### Section 6: Student Performance in Postsecondary Institutions



TEC Section 39.606 requires each district to publish, as part of its Annual Report, a report on student performance in postsecondary institutions during the first year enrolled after graduation from high school.



These data are compiled by the Texas Education Coordinating Board (THECB).




The most current report is for 2019-2020 high school graduates.

- Student performance is measured by the Grade Point Average (GPA) earned by 2019-2020 high school graduates who attended public four-year and two-year institutions of higher education in fiscal year 2021.
- For each student, the grade points and college-level semester credit hours earned by the student in the fall 2020, spring 2021 and summer 2021 are added together and averaged to determine the GPA.



Each LEA receives one of four special education determination levels (DLs):

Needs Intervention

Needs Substantial Intervention
