We have a vehicle in Billings still that needs to be picked up but the reservation is in quarantine so we have not been able to get it we usually use this vehicle to put our plow on and plow our bus garage parking lot so we can get our buses out of the stalls in the winter months and we use it to spread gravel where it is needed in the school district.
