Cafeteria prices for 2014-2015

Background: The MISD Student Nutrition program tries to break even each year. We have been successful with this the last three years. We ran a deficit for about three years prior to that due to a combination of old equipment, charging low prices, higher vendor prices and a slowdown in the economy. The Department of Agriculture has taken an involvement in cafeteria prices by creating a worksheet that each school is required to use to determine if they are meeting the guideline price of \$2.65 or the weighted average of their meals for the month of October. Using this formula, we are three cents below where we need to be for 2014-2015. Please review the attached price sheet.
