AGENDA ITEM: Consider Approval of 2019-2020 Child Nutrition Meal Prices

PRESENTER: Earl Husfeld

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Due to requirements implemented by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) through the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, school districts are required to calculate meal prices according to the Paid Lunch Equity Tool on a yearly basis.
- The meal prices calculated are established by a weighted average price formula.
- USDA also stipulates that adult meal pricing may not be supplemented by Child Nutrition Department revenues.
- Based on the USDA prescribed calculations, the following meal prices are recommended for the 2019-2020 school year:
 - Elementary lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$2.85 (presently \$2.75)
 - o Intermediate lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$2.95 (presently \$2.85)
 - Middle School lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$3.10 (presently \$3.00)
 - o Ninth Grade lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$3.35 (presently \$3.25)
 - High School lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$3.35 (presently \$3.25)
 - High School "Ultimate Meal" lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$4.35 (currently \$4.25)
 - Adult lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$3.95 (presently \$3.85)
 - Adult "Ultimate Meal" lunch price increase of 10 cents to \$4.95 (presently \$4.85)
 - Student breakfast price (at all campuses) increase of 10 cents to \$1.60 (presently \$1.50)
 - Adult breakfast price increase of 15 cents to \$2.15 (presently \$2.00)
