FO (LOCAL): STUDENT DISCIPLINE

- Wording change regarding video and audio recording equipment being in use.

FOB (LOCAL): STUDENT DISCIPLINE: SUSPENSION

- This policy allowed us to use our District of Innovation (DOI) to be exempt from the state law that limited the district's ability to suspend students (OSS) below grade 3.
 - Recommended for deletion because the state now allows schools to suspend students below grade 3.

GF (LOCAL): PUBLIC COMPLAINTS

- Filing Deadline - Within 15 business days of when they knew or should have known
- Hearing within 10 calendar days, written decision within 20 (both were 10 business days).
- Appeal within 20 calendar days (was 10 business days)
- Board or Board committee must hear a Level 3 appeal within 60 calendar days of the Level 2 decision
- Within 5 days of the hearing, the Superintendent shall provide the complainant a description of any information the Board intends to rely on that is not contained in the record created at the previous hearing levels.
- Complainant gets to determine open or closed meeting unless specified otherwise by law.
- Decision within 30 calendar days

GKA (LOCAL): COMMUNITY RELATIONS: CONDUCT ON SCHOOL PREMISES

- HB 6 no longer permits DOI exemptions to TEC Chapter 37: Discipline
 - Were exempt from having to keep a record of verbal warnings issued before refusing entry or ejecting a person from property under the District's control.
 - Were able to make them go through the districts normal grievance procedures. Now they can go straight to the Board within 90 calendar days of filing the initial complaint unless it gets resolved before the Board considers it.
