

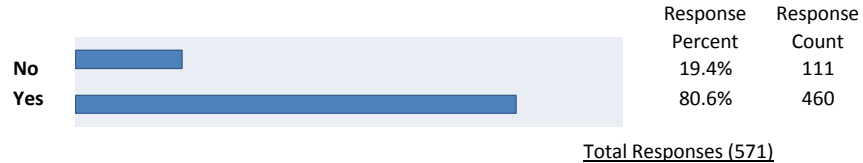
VICKSBURG COMMUNITY SCHOOL BUDGET SURVEY RESULTS

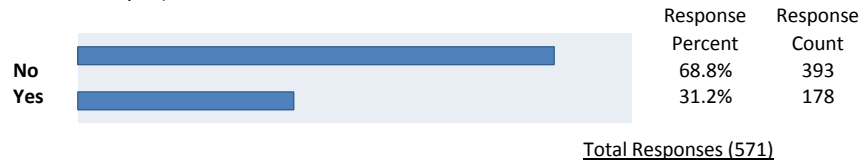
1. Would you be in favor of pay-to-participate fees to maintain athletic and extra-curricular programs at the middle school and high school?
