### Celebrating the 2024-25 School Year

Our last week of school was filled with joyful celebrations and sentimental goodbyes!

We had the Wildwood Walk, firetruck field day visit, and special all-school and grade-level events.









#### Class of 2025 Graduation

Nine merit scholars and five students with an unweighted GPA of 4.0.

Almost 30% of the Class of 2025 has a GPA of 3.7 or higher.

Five students from the Class received awards from the Minnesota Bilingual Seals Program. 54 Class of 2025 students received a certificate of recognition for passing the Spanish Language Proficiency exam.

★Over 150 student-athletes from the Class of 2025 contributed to 26 Conference Championships, 22 Section Championships, and 3 State Championships. Over 20 are continuing their education as collegiate athletes at the NCAA Division I & II levels.
