

Denton ISD McKinney-Vento Homeless and Foster Care Report School Board Meeting - August 8, 2023

Foundational Information:

McKinney-Vento

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act is a federal program that removes barriers to education for children and youth experiencing homelessness. The McKinney-Vento Homeless Act defines homelessness as individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence, including children and youth who are sharing the housing of other persons temporarily due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason. McKinney-Vento students are identified once a year. Once identified, students are considered homeless and receive services for the remainder of the year.

Foster Care


When children cannot live safely at home and no appropriate non-custodial parent, relative, or close family friend is willing and able to care for them, the court can give temporary legal possession to CPS. CPS temporarily places these children in foster care. Foster care settings include:

- Foster family homes.
- Foster family group homes.
- Residential group care facilities.
- Facilities overseen by another state agency.

General Services Provided:


- Educational stability If the student moves, the student can remain at the school of origin for the remainder of the school year.
- In and out of district transportation If the student moves to a different school or zone within DISD transportation is provided. If the student moves outside of the district, transportation is coordinated between the two school districts to provide transportation.
- Free lunch and school supplies.
- Immediate enrollment: Districts cannot require students experiencing homelessness or who are in a foster care placement to provide proof of residency, immunizations, birth certificates, guardianship documents, or any other sort of required paperwork before enrolling.
- Verification of homelessness for seniors for the purposes of financial aid and FAFSA completion. Tuition and fees exemption from state supported colleges and universities for former or current foster care students.
- Case management by Licensed Master Social Worker.




