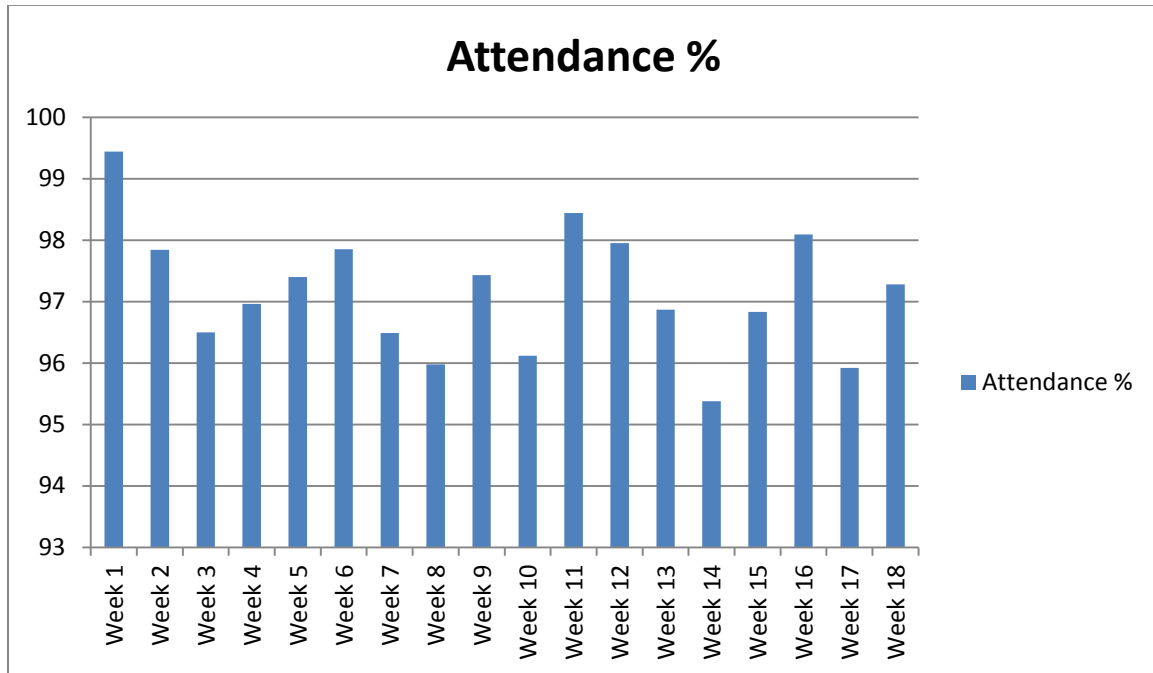

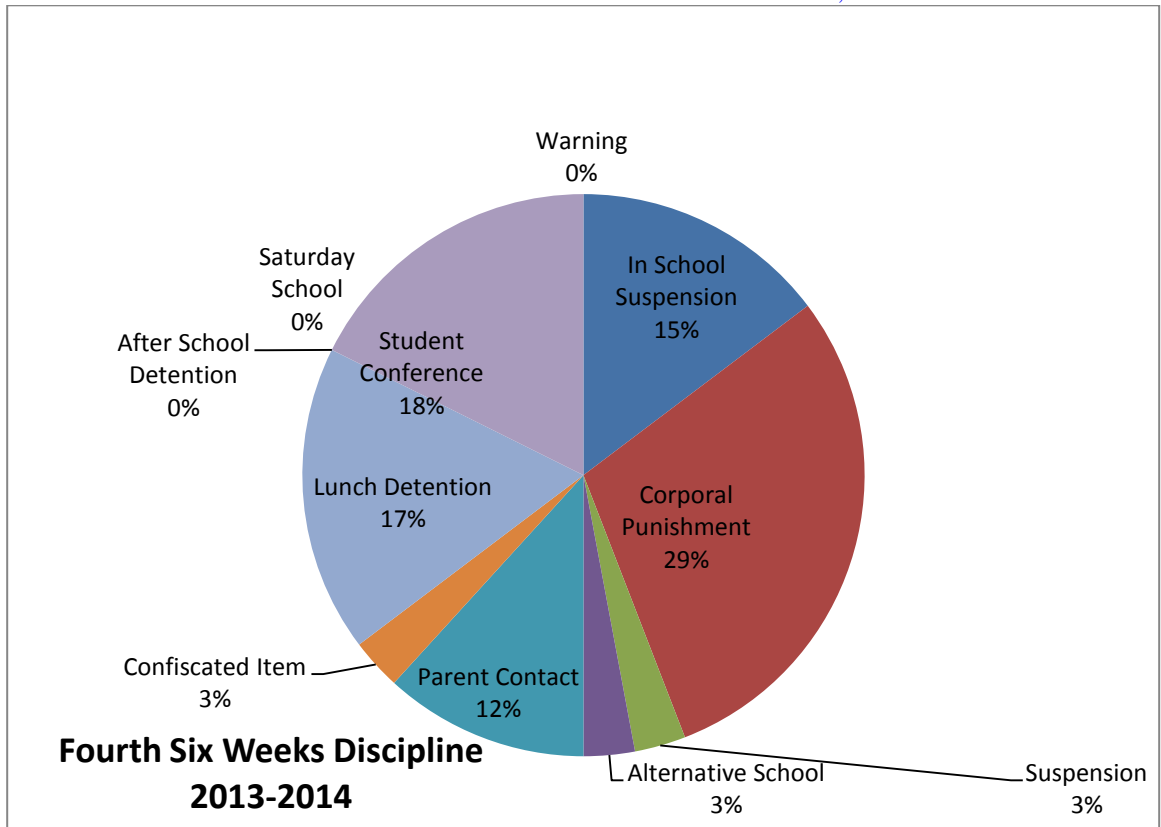

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College and Career Readiness

Our College and Career Readiness Tour will be as follows:

The main goal of this tour is to allow our students to experience the college atmosphere and to help them get excited about the endless possibilities that college presents. Hopefully, this tour will inspire all of our students to apply somewhere.

Core Academic Learning

Retest scores are back. Our results are listed below:

- English I Reading: 8 of 16 (50%) passed
- English I Writing: 1 of 18 (5.6%) passed
- English II Reading: 5 out of 7 (71.4%) passed
- English II Writing: 8 out of 15 (53.3%) passed
- Algebra I: 4 out of 4 (100%) passed
- Biology: 1 out of 5 (20%) passed

The ELA assessments still appear to be our weakest areas. There are several types of essays that students are required to write. In their writing, it appears that they are combining elements of each essay. The work continues...

Mrs. Toni Baxter, TLI Liaison, will return to Chilton ISD on February 5 and February 14 to continue work with our 10th grade ELA students. We are focusing on 10th grade because these students historically struggle with English performance. Additionally, our 10th grade ELA performance was significantly lower than the other grades. We are hoping that Mrs. Baxter's expertise will help improve our students' performance on the ELA exam.

We are in the process of seeking funding so that we can more adequately implement a Tiered instructional model at the secondary campus. We have spoken and left messages with two sources to try and make this a reality. One of the most important necessities is to employ a secondary math specialist to help our biggest strugglers in math. Additionally, we must determine how we are going to modify our Learning Lab so that students so that students will have additional opportunities for pull-outs.

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
