- 5. The vendor's past relationship with the district; 5 pts
- 6. The impact on the ability of the district to comply with the laws and rules relating to historically under-utilized businesses; 0 pts
- 7. The total long-term cost to the district to acquire the vendor's goods and services; 5 pts &
- 8. Any other relevant factor specifically listed in this RFP. 5 pts
