**Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?**

With the changes in interdistrict transfer laws, it is essential that we set a cap for incoming transfers for the school year 2019-20. The board will need to determine the number of slots open for out of district transfers for next school year. It is my recommendation that we open up a minimum of slots this year.

**Provide history/background information on your proposal.**

Last year we opened up 86 slots and filled 64. Given our class sizes, existing enrollment numbers and the large number of remainder of the year requests, opening a limited number of slots seems appropriate.

**List the advantages of your proposal:**

This procedure follows the new interdistrict transfer laws and policies and allows us as much flexibility to meet student/building needs as possible.

**List possible disadvantages of your proposal:**

Potential impact on staffing ratios/class sizes. However, we will have certain grade levels at the elementary level in various buildings that will be closed to transfers to limit this impact.
