Background Information

In accordance with Texas Education Code §31.1011 and Board Policy CMD (Legal), school districts are required to annually certify that:

- All students have access to instructional materials aligned to the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for all required subjects (excluding physical education), and
- The district complies with state and federal requirements to protect students from access to obscene or harmful content.

This certification is submitted through the state’s annual Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment (IMTA) process.

Recommendation

Approve the annual certification verifying that Duncanville ISD:

- Provides students access to TEKS-aligned instructional materials in all required content areas, and
- Maintains safeguards to prevent access to obscene or harmful content in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
