What Is Commit?



- The Commit Partnership is a collective impact organization that brings together schools, governments, nonprofits, foundations, and employers across Dallas County and Texas to strengthen the educational system.
- Commit provides research and data on TEA accountability, early childhood education, and many other areas that impact education.
- Commit seeks to increase the access that all students have to enrich educational experiences, and to increase the quality of educational experiences through their research.

Data Sharing Agreement



- Research studies may require student or campus data.
- Commit agrees to protect any personally identifiable information released and will follow all Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA") guidelines.
- Information that contains personally identifiable information will be submitted in secure formats. *No social security numbers will be released.*
- There is no cost to the district for the partnership.
- This MOU is a **renewal** so that the district may continue the existing partnership with Commit for research projects.
