Objectives:

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from PEIMS from March 20, 2018 through May 24, 2018.

Operational Impact:

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results:

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD 5th cycle was 96.29%.
- The 5th cycle lowest total attendance average for any given campus by grade level was 92.23% at 12th grade; followed by 93.47 at 10th grade. *(excluding EE and PK as well as Davis, JJAEP and FMHS).*
- The 5th cycle highest attendance average for any given campus by grade level was 98.66% at 5th grade; followed by 98.54% at 1st grade. *(excluding EE and PK as well as Davis, JJAEP and FMHS).*
- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD 6th cycle was 96.61%.
- The 6th cycle lowest total attendance average for any given campus by grade level was 78.00% at 12th grade; followed by 92.21% at 12th grade. *(excluding EE and PK as well as Davis, JJAEP and FMHS).*
- The 6th cycle highest attendance average for any given campus by grade level was 98.79% at 1st grade; followed by 98.70% at 4th grade. *(excluding EE and PK as well as Davis, JJAEP and FMHS).*

• Comparison:

- 2017 5^{th} cycle was 95.88% and 6^{th} cycle was 95.95%
- 2016 5^{th} cycle was 95.33% and 6^{th} cycle was 95.55%
- 2015 5^{th} cycle was 95.01% and 6^{th} cycle was 95.77%
- 2014 5^{th} cycle was 95.60 % and 6^{th} cycle was 95.87%
- 2013 5^{th} cycle was 95.86% and 6^{th} cycle was 96.22%
