Minidoka County School District Food service Report November 2018

Claims;

- Howdy to ya all. We have seen another month come and go already. We are still trying to get breakfast numbers up but with the free breakfast for everyone in the past, it is a hard process. Our served breakfast numbers for the month of November of 2018 were 18,255 and for 2017 there were 29,077. Comparing served breakfast from November 2018 and October of 2018 we did show a daily increase of 47 meals served. It is probably a better comparison to compare breakfast month to month this school year to see if we are increasing out meal counts.
- The lunch program is showing an increase of 110 meals for the month of November 2018 over 2017. We served the same number of days this year compared to last year. Our numbers for 2018 are 46,626 and for 2017 are 46,516. We are serving on average 2,743 lunches each day of school.
- Our total claim for the month of November 2018 was for \$147,676.47. Last year was \$158,943.35.

Projects;

The Minico High project is completed. We have some security motion detectors to install in the new section of the warehouse and also new doors locks on the back door on the east side and the back door on the south side.

We are still serving about 40 kids a day at the after-school-program at Rupert Elementary.
