B. PASS/FAIL

Pass/Fail arrangements are to be decided in the first ten (10) days of the semester and may not apply to a required subject. A PASSING grade will not affect a students GPA. A FAILING grade WILL affect the GPA. No weighted course may be taken Pass/Fail.

XXI. HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION Page 11

It should be noted that a student receiving homebound services is not eligible to participate in extra-curricular activities unless he/she is released by a doctor to physically attend school for one (1) semester prior to the activities. Additionally, a student receiving homebound services is not eligible to attend any school function unless he/she is released to physically attend school for nine (9) weeks prior to the activities. Activities include, but are not limited to limited to: athletics, dances and field trips.

XXIV. LOCKERS Page 13

Students MUST keep this lock on their locker at all times. Failure to comply with this directive may result in disciplinary action.

Students will not be permitted to use a backpack during the school day. They are permitted to use backpacks to carry books and supplies to and from school but are not permitted to carry them between classes. No backpacks of any type are to be used to transport clothing to and from the gymnasium (this includes the string type). Special circumstances will be reviewed by the administration on an individual basis.
