POLICY TITLE Transportation of Students Due to Extraordinary Traffic Hazards

The following conditions may be considered as extraordinary traffic hazard areas which would be eligible for transportation:

- 1. The need to cross a State, U.S. or Interstate Highway.
- 2. The need to cross a county or state highway when the crossing is not controlled either by a 4-way stop, signals, or crossing guard.
- 3. The crossing of a major feeder route when the crossing is not controlled either by a 4-way stop signal, crossing guard, or pedestrian crosswalk.
- 4. County or township roads with shoulders or with narrow shoulders and with a posted speed limit in excess of 30 MPH.
- 5. The need to cross railroad tracks.
- 6. Age of students.
- 7. Other special conditions that might be considered as dangerous to the safety of pupils as determined by he supervisor of transportation.
