Naming New Facilities

The Board will select names for schools.

In considering names for schools, preference will be given to names associated with the community. Names of historical persons, places and events may be subsequently considered. Names of persons who are living or have been deceased less than three years will not be considered.

Recommendations from Community Engagement Committees, parent groups, other organizations and residents of the district parents, students, staff and the community will be considered.

Locations within a school or ancillary facility (e.g., auditorium, athletic fields) shall not be given separate names; however, the Superintendent in his or her discretion can permit a collective memorial that equitably honors deceased members of a school or the District community (e.g., "Memorial Garden" or "Veterans Plaza"). (Moved to proposed policy FFA - Memorials)

The Superintendent will, upon request, prepare for the Board a list of possible names for each new school. The Superintendent also shall develop an AR that describes the process for the application for and approval of a collective memorial and that includes a list of other suitable memorials for honoring deceased students and staff. (Moved to proposed policy FFA)
