

FPC Rahll Campus Board Report March 2026

- ESL and GED Spring I classes finished this week. We had forty-four students complete the program in ESL and fourteen students enrolled in GED. We have beginning, intermediate, and advanced ESL classes.
- The ESL class for CDL students started on February 9th.
- Christy met with Franky Scott to discuss CDL Truck/Trailer needs. Submitted the report to Don Smith per his request.
- Spring enrollment was up overall. The traditional student enrollment dropped some due to several of our students completing in December and others who were enrolled in the fall semester transferring out to a university. Dual Credit enrollment was up significantly.
- The first group of Dual Credit Diesel Technology students started classes this spring. We have sixty-four enrolled.
- Christy met with the counselors from the four schools the Rahll Campus serves to confirm dual credit student's enrollment, planning for the next school year, and to ensure the semester was going well.
- Administered ELAR and Math TSI to Dalhart HS students at the FPC campus.
- Christy attended a virtual meeting with Windham School District.
- FPC staff held a full workday in Dalhart to prepare for fall classes at the Dalhart TDCJ Unit. The Regional Director assigned to Frank Phillips College attended. The day was very productive.
- Yellow House toured the Rahll Campus Diesel Technology facility and met with students regarding an internship and other opportunities with the company.
- The new EDC Director in Dalhart is a dedicated supporter of FPC. He created vocational training advertising materials for the new electronic billboards which are located around Dalhart.
- Over the past month numerous CE and TCOLE classes were held on campus for Dalhart PD, Sherman County Sherriff's Office, DHCHD, and Hilmar.
- Christian and Mary distributed new ESL and GED flyers around town. The new classes will begin on March 23rd.
- Rahll Campus Advisory Board Meeting was held on March 4th.
- An Allied Heath meeting was held to discuss class fees, changes in requirements, and upcoming classes.
- Christy and Courtney will attend the Rotary Club meeting on March 12th to share campus updates.
- Construction has started for the new CDL training and testing area on campus. The dirt work and leveling are complete. They are setting the forms to pour the concrete.
- Met with the local EDC and community members to discuss their plans to include FPC in upcoming community projects.
