SUMMARY:

The item requests approval of the contract from College Board in the amount of \$158,114.00 for College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) through the administration of the SAT Suite of Assessments.

BOARD GOAL:

Opportunities for Students - Support college, career, military, and life readiness Growth & Management - demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The contract was previously approved in 2019-2020 and reflects the annual contract with College Board.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Denton ISD participates in the SAT Suite of Assessments to promote college readiness for all students. Under HB3, the District anticipates receiving a refund of testing in the amount of \$83,664.00.
